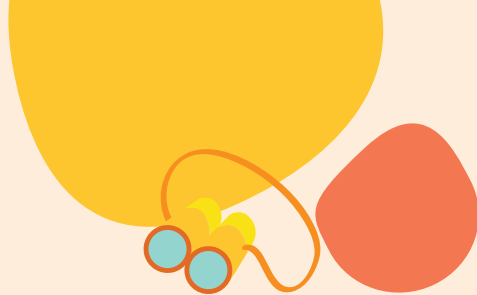




PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

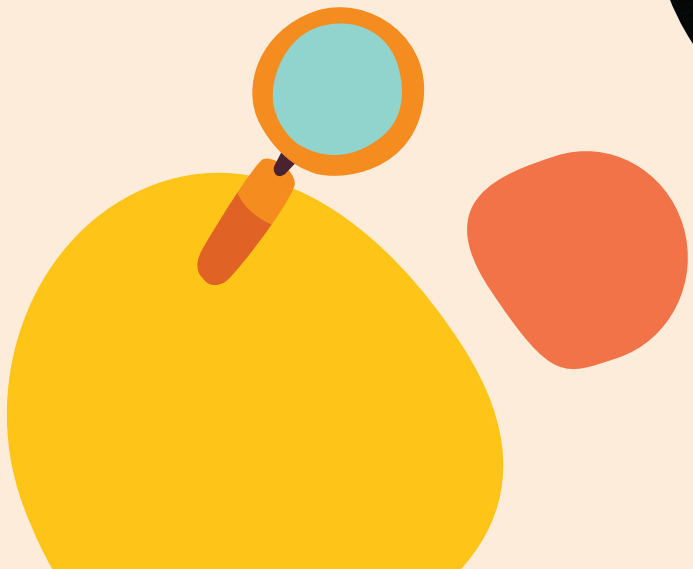
