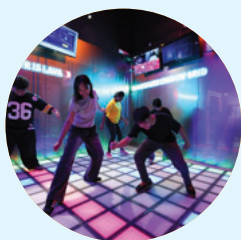

# SINGAPORE NAVY MUSEUM

The refreshed Singapore Navy Museum brings one on an enriching voyage through the rich history of the Republic of Singapore Navy (RSN), a *Maritime Force* for a *Maritime Nation*. It highlights how the RSN has evolved into a maritime nation, playing the critical role of keeping our waters safe and secure. Notably, the museum features artefacts from RSS *Panglima* that tell the story of the RSN's first ship, as well as a showcase of the original equipment from the RSN's *Challenger*-class submarine.

1990s to Present

The locally designed and built Challenger-class patrol vessels (PCV) replaced the OCEC in serving the security of Singapore's waters and seas. Following the decommissioning of the ships from 50 years of service, five of the ships were refurbished and found new life as the Challenger-class Maritime Security & Operations Vessels (MSO).

The Michoud-class Missile Corvettes (MCM) gave the RSN its first brand of anti-submarine warfare capability, marking the Navy's first successful modernisation in 1996.

This immersive experience celebrates the heritage, ethos and unwavering spirit that have shaped the RSN's enduring legacy. Embark on a journey to learn about the navy's humble beginnings to its present-day excellence. Be captivated by the interactive exhibits, diverse displays of artefacts and be inspired by remarkable stories of our service personnel, both past and present.

# SILENT WATERS

Dive into Singapore's submarine world with Silent Waters, an immersive programme on naval science and defence. Students explore the submarine gallery, conduct hands-on experiments on density and buoyancy, and engage in a strategy game as RSN vessels. Along the way, they develop teamwork, resilience, and a deeper appreciation for the role of submarines in safeguarding the nation's seas.

- Understand the role that the Navy plays in the defence of Singapore and how submarines secure Singapore's trade routes.
- Learn about the different submarines of the RSN and their uses.
- Gain insights into how pressure plays a part in the movement of a submarine.
